Commemoration Trees at Cannizaro Park

The Friends of Cannizaro Park works in partnership with Merton Council with the aim of maintaining and restoring the landscape, trees and plants of Cannizaro Park for all local residents to enjoy.

Merton Council do all they can to maintain the park infrastructure and to keep the park safe, as well as providing core gardening services.

The Friends of Cannizaro Park was created in 1997 to do more: with the aim of renovating and improving the park, and promoting it as a place for recreation and relaxation for local residents.

While entirely run by volunteers, funds are still needed to improve and renew planting within the park and offer events for visitors.

Commemoration trees are a vital part of this renewal work. Carefully chosen trees enhance Cannizaro's already notable tree collection; they are also one way in which the Friends can raise money for the benefit of the park and all visitors, while enabling people with a strong connection to the park to remember a loved one when visiting.

Thank you for considering commemorating a tree at Cannizaro Park. Your commemoration money will go towards enhancing the park landscape for decades to come, for all visitors to the park to enjoy.

The following pages detail the terms for tree commemorations, an application form and payment details.

Terms and Conditions

1. Tree commemoration costs are calculated as the cost of the tree itself, plus a guide donation of £300-£500 to cover delivery, planting labour and materials, ongoing care and a contribution to the Friends. Commemoration lasts for the life of the tree.
2. Only a small number of trees are added to the park each year so there may be a waiting list maintained by the Friends Secretary.
3. New trees for the park are decided in July each year. The Friends Secretary will discuss with you available locations for new trees within the park. Nearer the time of planting, suitable and available trees, as agreed with Merton Council, will be discussed from which selection is made.
4. Trees are purchased and planted between November and February.
5. Once planted, Friends volunteers will care for and water the trees regularly as needed, for at least the first year and while the trees establish themselves. Our tree planting has a high rate of success; however, the Friends cannot guarantee that a tree will survive and we cannot guarantee a replacement if it does not. Should a tree die, the Friends will try to obtain a replacement tree from the supplier if circumstances permit.
6. Sponsors may have a small plaque fixed to the tree containing information about the tree with space for a dedication. The dedication will display a maximum of two lines of engraved lettering, consisting of no more than 30 characters per line including spaces and punctuation. All wording is to be approved by The Friends of Cannizaro Park prior to engraving. An example image is shown on the next page.
7. To maintain the feel of a park, the plaque will be fixed to the tree itself and not placed on the ground. Examples of the plaques and fixing can be seen on trees at the entrance to the park.
8. Sponsors may not attempt to maintain, affix anything to or adjust the immediate environs of a commemorative tree without the agreement of The Friends of Cannizaro Park / Merton Council. Sponsors may not plant any flora in the vicinity of the tree.
9. It is the responsibility of the sponsor/s to contact The Friends of Cannizaro Park to advise of any change of contact details if they wish to be contacted regarding any future decisions regarding the tree.
